


Welcome




Northside Therapy Collective (NTC) was created as a space committed to ethical practice at all levels.



NTC is curated by four women with queer, person of colour, neurodivergent and migrant lived experience.




The new site is Level 1 (upstairs), 680 High St, Thornbury (above Premier Sports & Spinal Medicine)

The 86 trams runs right to our door at stop 39 and Thornbury train station (on the Mernda line) is 550m away.



There is 1hr parking on High St and 2hr parking on Raleigh St and All day parking past 29 Raleigh St.




The entry is through glass doors on the High St side of the building



Inside is the physiotherapy reception who are available to help direct you to our waiting area.



You walk to the right and then back of the space (before the planters) and down the corridor to the bottom of the staircase.




You are welcome to sit and get a drink of water. There are toilets downstairs or you are welcome to come upstairs to the NTC All Genders Bathroom.




Your therapist will meet you at the bottom of the stairs to walk with you to the therapy room.
